\*Base salary includes a in-District transportation and miscellaneous expense allowance of \$12,000 per year for Asst. Superintendent/Vice President of Instruction and Asst. Superintendent/Vice President of Student Services.

Longevity increases of 2.5% of the base salary will be applied as follows:  
Effective July 1 of the ninth (9th), thirteenth (13th), seventeenth (17th), twenty-first (21st), and twenty-fifth (25th) years of consecutive, continuous employment.

Managers possessing an earned doctorate receive an additional salary; the difference between column VI and column VII of the faculty salary schedule. For 2016-2017 through 2018-19 this amount is \$2,311 annually.
