** PROJECT UPDATES **

Construction activity throughout the campus is picking up pace. The football, track, and softball facilities are starting to take shape; ground work on the Student Services Building site is moving ahead; infrastructure improvement work is underway on North Burke Bradley Road; and coming soon will be the bustling activity of the Goleman Building renovation.

Physical Education/Recreation & Athletics (PERA) - Football/Track and Softball Facilities

Delta College Library Relocation

At the end of the day Friday, May 30, 2008, Goleman Library will close its doors and will be the last occupant of the Goleman Building to move to a temporary location to make way for renovation. The library will be closed until June 23, 2008, when it will reopen at its new location (see map below). utility installation is done, watch for the concrete foundation to be poured. Concurrently, the entrance road to the Child Development Center will be repaved and curbing and sidewalks will be installed. North Road Infrastructure Project

Infrastructure work is now taking place to support new and remodeled buildings and allow Delta to efficiently meet future needs as growth continues. Work includes: relocation of utilities, fire and domestic water, sewer, storm drainage, and gas lines to provide points of connection for construction on the campus; adjustments to roadways to improve traffic flow; and expansion of electrical and low voltage services.
