The Student Portal!

Delta College is pleased to announce the launch of the MyDelta Student Portal! This project, under the direction of Greg Greenwood and lots of great programming from Information Services, is the culmination of a process that began nearly a year ago and became a reality on August 6th. The project was intended to make use of "portal" technology to create an improved experience for students who want to interact with the college through any one of the myriad of online services we offer.

Portals are vastly superior to the old web page concept in a variety of aspects including navigation, integration of services, personalization of services and overall utilitarian value to the user.

To find the portal, go to www.deltacollege.edu, under Hot Topics, and click on “Try our new Student Portal. You will log in with your e-mail address and PIN. For example, if your student e-mail address is jsmith123@students.deltacollege.edu, your log in would be jsmith123. Your password is the same one you use for online registration or e-mail access.
