EOPS Summer Readiness Program (SRP) Application Workshops have been scheduled to provide you with an overview of this year's SRP program, eligibility and assistance with completing the application process. The application workshops will be held on each of the following dates:

The EOPS Program at San Joaquin Delta College admits a maximum of 100 first-time college students qualified into the 2009 Summer Readiness Program (SRP) on a first-come, first-served basis. ***All eligible SRP participants will be registered in a combination of Guidance and Study Skills courses for a total of 8 units. Classes meet Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am to 2:30 p.m., beginning June 15 through July 24, 2009; Fridays are reserved for special activities.***

Since space in the SRP program is limited to the first 100 qualified applicants we encourage you to complete the following before attending the SRP application workshop:

1. Delta College admissions application;

3. 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to receive aid during Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 semesters, and 2009 SRP grant.
4. 2008-2009 FAFSA for an additional Summer 2009 Pell Grant only. Check with Delta College's Financial Aid office regarding file completion deadline of 2008-2009 FAFSA.
5. Board of Governors Fee Waiver (BOGW) to cover summer 2009 tuition costs.
6. Visit your high school counselor to obtain an unofficial copy of your high school transcript. Bring this with you to the SRP workshop.
