EOPS provides supportive services to students who meet specific educational and income criteria. The EOPS staff will provide assistance with: individualized counseling, book service, priority registration, transportation, completion of the financial aid application, transfer services, workshops and special events. All financial services are contingent upon budget availability.

As an EOPS student accepting these support services, I agree to:

- Maintain satisfactory progress towards earning an associate degree, certificate and/or transfer requirements.
- Complete a minimum of 12 units each semester; unless approved for less than 12 units.
- Maintain a minimum 2.00 semester and cumulative grade point average ('C' average).
- Follow my Student Educational Plan (SEP) which is developed and/or revised with my EOPS counselor.
- Complete EOPS Priority Registration on the first date each semester.
- Complete three EOPS Academic Progress Reports (APR) to assess my progress in each course each semester.
- Meet with an EOPS Counselor three times each semester for academic counseling, monitoring, and evaluation.
- Inform my EOPS counselor when I am experiencing any difficulties which may affect my academic progress.
- Authorize my EOPS counselor to contact my instructors for a report of my academic progress.
- Notify my EOPS counselor when adding or dropping classes; and before terminating my attendance.

- Attend EOPS sponsored workshops; and meet with a tutor as needed to assist with my coursework and progress.
- Apply for state (BOGW) and federal (FAFSA) financial aid each academic year.
- Check my deltagcollege.edu e-mail account several times a week and read all EOPS correspondence.
- Give permission for my academic achievements (ex. Dean's list, scholarships, degree) to be recognized in EOPS publications, website and/or related printed material. See EOPS staff if you do not wish to be recognized.

I understand that:

- My EOPS eligibility is limited to six consecutive semesters or 70 degree applicable units, whichever comes first.
- I must qualify for federal aid and have 'unmet need' as determined by SJDC's Financial Aid Office to receive EOPS grants.
- I affirm that the information I reported on my EOPS Application is correct and true. Information found to be incorrect, misleading and/or false may disqualify me from receiving EOPS services.

Acceptance of EOPS support services means I will comply with this contract. Continuing eligibility is determined based upon compliance with this contract each semester. Failure to comply will result in EOPS probation or dismissal. If I am placed on probation all EOPS support services will be reduced and I will be required to satisfy additional program requirements. If I am dismissed, I must sit-out two semesters before reapplying to EOPS.
