## About San Joaquin Delta College

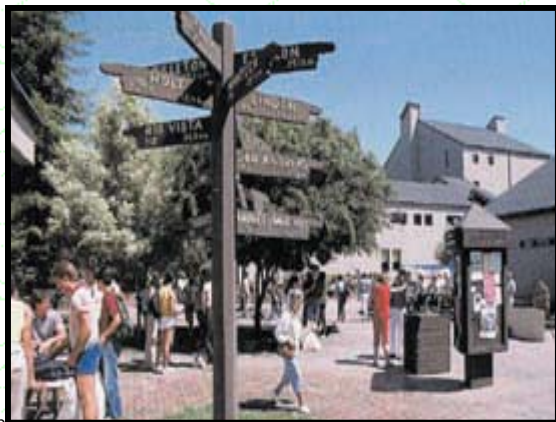

**1. Online Application** -All potential students must complete the online admission application at: [www.deltacollege.edu](http://www.deltacollege.edu)

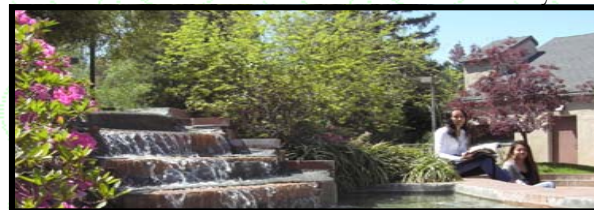
