Thank you for your interest in EOPS, a unique program funded by the State of California and San Joaquin Delta College to encourage academic access, retention, persistence and success of students challenged by economic and educational barriers and who will complete a certificate, associate degree or university transfer. EOPS students receive individualized counseling, priority registration, assistance purchasing required textbooks, grants, transfer services and specialized workshops and activities. *Please note: all financial services are based upon budget availability.* EOPS serves program participants until they have acquired 70 degree applicable units or six consecutive semesters in the program, whichever comes first.

To Be Eligible for EOPS Students Must:

1. Be eligible for the Board of Governors Grant Fee Waiver (BOGW A or B only)
2. Be **enrolled** in 12 units; wait list classes will not count.*
3. Have completed **no more** than 40 degree applicable units.
4. Meet **one** of the following educational criteria:
 - a. Assessment into a basic skills English, ESL or Math course.
 - b. Not a high school graduate or GED recipient.
 - c. Graduated from high school with less than a 2.5 GPA.
 - d. Previously enrolled in remedial education.

***Unit exceptions may be available for DSPS participants. Speak to an EOPS staff member for details.**

EOPS ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST

Before staff can determine EOPS eligibility, students must have completed the following:

- Delta College Assessment Placement (A/P)
- Apply for the Board of Governors Grant Waiver (BOGW A or B only)
- Enroll in 12 units; wait listed classes do not count. **Attach a copy of your spring 2012 class schedule.**
- If the only educational criteria you meet is 4c above; you must submit an unofficial high school transcript with your EOPS application (will **not** be returned).
- Students who have attended other colleges/universities must submit an unofficial transcript from each institution with your EOPS application (will **not** be returned).

FINAL STEPS: APPLY!

1. Complete and submit an EOPS application with all required documentation. Attach all transcripts and your spring 2012 schedule. Incomplete applications will not be accepted (see checklist above). Questions left unanswered on the student application will be considered an incomplete application. Do **not** fax the application and/or documents. At the time of the submission of your application/documents you will receive a receipt with extremely important information. Please read and keep your receipt as this will be your only proof of having submitted your application.
2. Applications will be reviewed to determine program eligibility. Eligible students are accepted on a first come, first served basis as space allows.
3. All applicants will be notified by Delta student e-mail. Students accepted into EOPS must attend a mandatory orientation to confirm program participation.
