1. Cunningham Center

Visit the E-Services Lab in Cunn. 226 for help completing the SJDC on-line application and/or for help completing the FAFSA. The Assessment Center is located in Cunn. 220, schedule an appointment to take your assessment once you have applied to SJDC and received your student identification number.

2. Shima Center

Shima is home to the Department of Family Consumer & Health Sciences, Delta Radio/TV, Greenhouse, Horton Art Gallery, CAT program and Student Activities.

The Math and Science Center in Shima 217 is a tutoring center where students can come to get free help with their classes and homework.

3. Danner Center

Located in the heart of campus directly in front of the Koi pond, Danner Hall offers a wealth of resources to for students including:

Counseling Center in Danner 205- A counselor will work with you to develop a Student Education Plan – a roadmap of the courses you need to complete in order to reach your educational goals.

Transfer Center Danner 202- The Transfer Center program is designed to facilitate a smooth transition for students transferring to a four-year college or university. Services, activities, and resources assist students to navigate through transfer admission and major preparation requirements, application timelines, transfer admission agreements, and college selection.
