Phase 1 (Fall)

- Preparatory English Writing Skills (Eng. 79)
- Orientation to College & Career/Life Planning
- Mentoring Activities

Phase 2 (Spring)

- Freshman Composition Writing (Eng. 1A)
- Cultural Awareness & Self Esteem
- Transition to University Life

Phases 1 & 2 (Fall/Spring)

- Mentoring Activities
- Leadership/Community Involvement
- College Tours & Cultural Field Trips

Phase 3 (Until Transfer)

- Individual Counseling
- Transfer Application Workshops
- Mentoring Activities

- Level II Reading & Composition
- Transfer Bound
- Make one year commitment
- Enroll full time – 12 units plus
- **Work no more than 20 hrs/wk**
