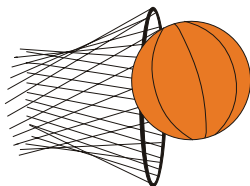

Jocelyn Mancebo

This is Jocelyn's third season as an assistant coach with the Delta College program. She is a former Mustang from the 2002-03 season. Jocelyn is a great asset to the Delta program because she is familiar with the expectations and is looking forward to having the opportunity to learn and coach under Coach Johnson.

Jocelyn played for head coach Gina Johnson at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton... playing point guard she was named to the California All Regional Team in 2002-03... Team MVP in 2003... Scored 14ppg, 4.9 apg and 3 spg... Finished her last season hitting 123-246 from the field and 35-86 beyond the arc. She currently holds the record for best 3 pt. shooting percentage at Delta. Jocelyn earned a full basketball scholarship to University of Nevada after her freshman season at Delta College.

As a sophomore at University of Nevada, Reno, Jocelyn was team captain... Lead the Wolf Pack in scoring, averaging 11 points per game. She finished second in the Western Athletic Conference in 3-pointers made, averaging 1.76 per game. She had a streak of 14 made free throws, the best on the team, and climbed to eighth in the school's record book for 3-pointers in a season (51) and ninth in steals (57). Also the only team member to start every game and averaged the most minutes played for the season.

Jocelyn has a Masters Degree in Kinesiology from Saint Mary's College in Moraga and plans on pursuing a career in coaching basketball at the college level.

Head Coach

Coach Johnson begins her 14th season with the Lady Mustang Basketball program and 18th as a Community College Head Coach (419-149). The Lady Mustangs have been a program to contend with since Coach Johnson took over in 1996 and led the Mustangs to their 1997 Bay Valley Conference title - the first ever at Delta College! Under Coach Johnson, the Mustangs have advanced to post season competition in twelve of her thirteen seasons as head coach.

The Delta Mustangs are coming off another championship year winning their 8th Conference Championship in a row and 9th overall. San Joaquin Delta Women's Basketball formed a new conference in 2005 and have been the only championship Women Basketball since the BIG 8 began. The Lady Mustangs just finished their 2008-09 season 31-7 and advancing to the California State Elite 8 Tournament for the 5th year in a row.

Coach Johnson believes in an up-tempo style of offense and tough defensive fullcourt play. Johnson's goal as a coach is to help develop her student-athletes on and off the basketball court. Her main objective is to prepare her athletes to transfer, and assist them in earning an athletic scholarship. Coach Johnson wants to do what it takes to prepare her student-athletes for the academic and athletic demands that four-year schools place on student-athletes.

A 1991 graduate of Cal Poly State University in San Luis Obispo, she finished her playing career in 1990 as a two-year starting guard for the Cal Poly Lady Mustangs. Prior to Cal Poly, Johnson was a junior college All-Conference player for DeAnza College. She was named MVP of the Coast Conference in 1988 and was honored as a player to the California Community College First Team All-State. She holds a Masters Degree in Health, Physical Education, and Recreation from St. Mary's College in Moraga. Coach Johnson is married to Mike Johnson and has two children- Brandon (11) and Brady (8).

Que K. Ngo enters his seventh season as part of the Delta College Women's Basketball program, preparing the Mustangs for another State Tournament appearance. Que has been a great addition to the Delta College staff with his vast experience in teaching fundamentals and knowledge of the game.

Prior to joining the Mustang staff, Que spent ten seasons at the High School level as head girls basketball coach at Buchanan High School, Caruther High School, Del Campo High School, Folsom High School, and Lincoln High School in Stockton.

Que served as Director of the Stockton Mustangs Girl's AAU Program since 2007. During Que's short term as an AAU coach, he has had the unique opportunity to watch former players advance to the Division I level.
