SUBJECT: Preparing for the nursing program

To assist students in planning and preparation for the nursing program, please note the following recommendations:

1. A physical exam is required prior to entry into the program. Since these exams may be difficult to schedule, it is recommended that applicants SCHEDULE a physical exam when you submit your application. The date of the exam should be after the ranking notification which should take place by mid-November.
2. Professional level or Health Care Provider level CPR is required prior to participation in clinical activities. It is recommended that potential students inquire about classes and enroll in a CPR class when their application is submitted or sooner, since it is often difficult to locate an open class in December. Be sure to indicate that you need the Professional level or Health Care Provider level. This is the ONLY type of CPR which is accepted by the nursing program.
