#### College Diversity Committee

##### **Committee Responsibilities:**

Committee responsibilities: Monitor and review matters related to the development and implementation of the college's staff diversity/affirmative action program for staff and students, including equity issues, and evaluate progress toward affirmative action goals. Make recommendations for the promotion of equal employment and educational opportunity within the college.

##### **Committee Membership:**

Director of Human Resources and Affirmative Action, Director of Extended Opportunity Programs and Services, one division chairperson/director, Director of Disabled Students Programs and Services (as an expert on services for the disabled), Supervisor of Student Activities, three faculty members, two classified staff members, two students, two community representatives. The committee membership shall include at least one each from the following categories: Asian/Pacific Islander, African-American, Hispanic, women, disabled, senior citizens, and veterans. Committee members may represent more than one category. Employees of the college may not serve as community representatives.
