

Part One – Student Access**Enrollments in Day, Evening and Internet Courses**

The College has experienced relatively steady enrollments in its evening course sections, which is a benchmark of consistent access for returning adult students and those pursuing part-time education while employed (Figure 8). There had been a slight decline in traditional daytime course offerings (a drop from 72 percent of enrollments to 70 percent between 1997 and 2002), but that trend was offset by increases in non-traditional weekend and Internet classes. Fall 2003 daytime courses returned to 72% while the evening and internet/weekend offers showed a slight decline.
