

**Part Two – Student Success****Most Common 4-Year Transfer Institutions**

Figure 25 highlights the trend in transfers to several four-year universities, once again focusing on the cohort of first-time, degree seeking freshman students who enrolled at the College in fall 1995 through 1998. California State University at Sacramento is the transfer institution of choice for the largest proportion of students, ranging between 14 and 19 percent of the cohort across the four years. Consistently second in popularity have been CSU Stanislaus and University of the Pacific. The top three institutions all share the common trait of geographic proximity to the College, and in most years, the UC campus that receives the most transfers is also the most proximate (UC Davis). The data suggest that the College provides a steady supply of regional transfer students to nearby four-year universities.
