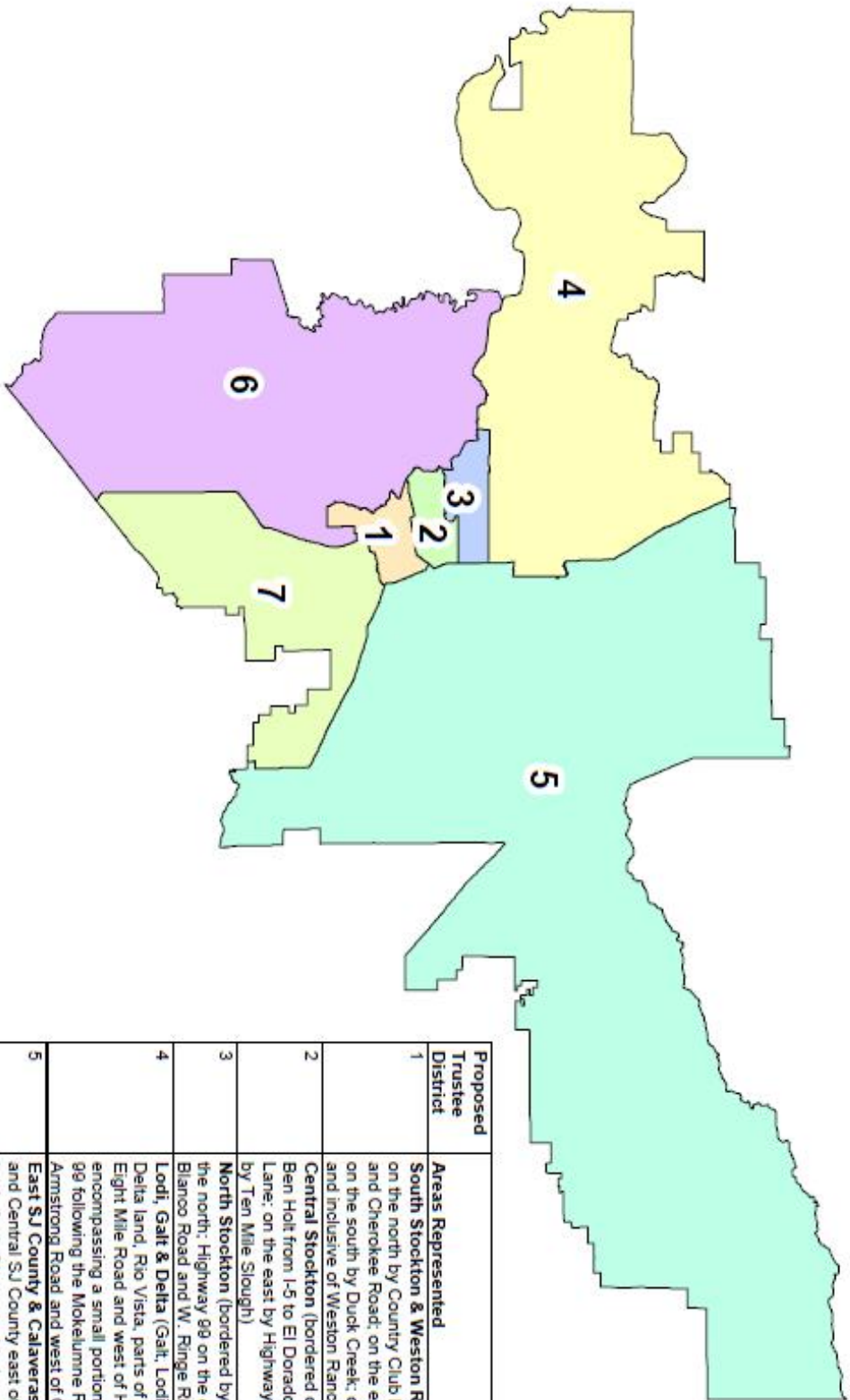

2	Central Stockton (bordered on the north by Ben Holt from I-5 to El Dorado, then Hammer Lane; on the east by Highway 98; on the West by Ten Mile Slough)	75,158
3	North Stockton (bordered by Eight Mile Rod on the north; Highway 98 on the east; and Rio Blanco Road and W. Ringe Road on the west).	74,405
4	Lodi, Galt & Delta (Galt, Lodi, Woodbridge, Delta land, Rio Vista, parts of the district north of Eight Mile Road and west of Highway 98 encompassing a small portion east of Highway 98 following the Mokelumne River south towards Armstrong Road and west of Curry Ave)	74,395
5	East SJ County & Calaveras (Portions of North and Central SJ County east of Highway 99; Lockeford, Clements, Linden, Escalon, Calaveras County minus the portion portion east of Highway 99 following the Mokelumne River south towards Armstrong Road and west of Curry Ave)	75,097
6	Tracy, Mountain House. (bordered by the south and west county border, north to roughly Eight Mile Road - South and West SJ County)	75,593
