## B. STATEMENT OF ISSUE/PURPOSE

### 1. Purpose and Background:

1.1 The Coalition to Save Public Education was formed by concerned citizens and activists in San Joaquin County with the belief that a healthy, thriving public education system is the backbone of every community providing all those within the community equal educational opportunities for a better future.

1.2 The Coalition to Save Public education emphasizes the following:

- The need to restore and guarantee quality public education.
- A government and economy that works for all people.
- Fair taxes to fund California's Education - our future.

### 2. Status:

1.1 The San Joaquin County Coalition to Save Public Education will be sponsoring a march on March 4, 2010 from downtown Stockton to San Joaquin Delta College where a candlelight vigil will be held to draw the communities attention to the impact of the proposed cuts to education and how these cuts will directly affect all levels of education in San Joaquin County.

1.2 On March 5, 2010 a "March for California's Future" will take place from Bakersfield to Sacramento for six weeks to focus public attention on the severity of the state budget crisis.

Whereas over \$20 billion has been slashed from the California state budget over the past two budget years, and the Governor has proposed still more cuts in 2010-11, and;

Whereas cuts in public education, public health services, public safety programs, and public infrastructure result in a deterioration of the vital services that the people of California need and deserve, and;

Whereas while these valued programs and services were being cut, the Governor and Legislature passed tax cuts and created loopholes for corporations and the richest residents of the state, and;

Whereas March 4, 2010 has been designated a day of action in support of public education and protest against further cuts to education, and;

Whereas the San Joaquin County Coalition to Save Public Education will be sponsoring a march on March 4, 2010 from downtown Stockton to the San Joaquin Delta Community College campus where a candlelight vigil will be held to draw our communities attention to the seriousness of the impact of the proposed cuts to education as it directly affects our county's primary, secondary and post secondary, schools, and;

Whereas a "March for California's Future" will take place on March 5, 2010 from Bakersfield to Sacramento for six weeks in order to focus public attention on the severity of the state budget crisis as well as to viable alternatives to a cuts-only approach, and;

Whereas the marches will promote the promise of public education; a government and economy that works for all Californians; and a fair budget.

Therefore be it resolved that the San Joaquin Delta Community College Board of Trustees supports the San Joaquin Coalition to Save Public Education's March for California's Future;
