Course Description: This course is an introduction to the Chinese language and Chinese cultures. Emphasis is placed on the following skills in the order given: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. (UC, CSU, CAN CHIN 2, CAN Sequence A with both CHIN 001 and CHIN 002)
