MINUTES

- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 2:52 p.m.
- II. **Communication**
 - A. **Comments from the Public:** There were no comments from the public.
- III. **Approval of the Minutes**
 - A. Approval of the July 18th, 2011 2:30 p.m. minutes were passed without any objections with the stated changes.
 - B. Approval of the July 25th, 2011 2:30 p.m. minutes were passed without any objections with the stated changes.
- IV. **Unfinished Business**
 - A. **Activities Report:** Vice President Taylor presented the schedule of events to come including college hours, mustang nights, and many more events that he is currently doing more research on.
 - B. **Arts and Fashion Event:** Vice President Taylor discussed partnering with an outside organization that is already planning an art event at Delta College; however no confirmation was made regarding a partnership. Vice President Taylor did state that he would like to have the art event on September 30th.
 - C. **Did You Know Table Budget:** *Representative Armstrong motioned to purchase 2 signs from Tracy sign with the cost of each sign being \$43.70, for a total of \$87.40, the motion was seconded. Vote: 7:0:0, the motion passed.*
 - D. **Id Card System:** This item was postponed by President Aguirre without any objections.
- V. **New Business**
 - A. **Org Sync/Student Voice:** Director Butler discussed the software/program org sync and stated that it can be very beneficial for students. The program has the ability to store all club records online so that way future board members of student clubs can easily see what past board members did, and also that all forms would be online. Director Butler stated that she will do further research and come back to the ASBG.
 - B. **Revised Flea Market Rules and Regulations:** Director Butler handed out a draft for a new ASBG Flea Market Rules and Regulations contract that vendors will receive when they apply to become sellers at the market. Director Butler stated that she would like for the members of the ASBG to review the draft and at the August 8th, 2:30 p.m. meeting for there to be discussion about the proposed draft.
 - C. **Changes with ID Cards:** President Aguirre suggested a change be made to the student ID card receipts, such as removing the written portion on the receipt stating that the student must redeem their ID within 15 days of purchasing their ID or else the receipt becomes void.
 - D. **Vacant Senator of Student Body ID Cards:** President Aguirre stated that while he understands board members feelings that the Senator of Student Body ID Cards should be removed and its responsibilities assigned to another position such as one of the Senators at Large, that he is bound by the ASBG Constitution. Therefore, President Aguirre followed the rights of ascension and Senator Angel Brott choose to ascend to the vacant position and will become the new Senator of Student Body ID Cards.
 - E. **Youtube Videos:** President Aguirre stated that he would like to start recording videos for the ASBG YouTube account as soon as possible, perhaps even at the New Student Welcome Day on August 9th. Representative Armstrong suggested that at the August 8th meeting ASBG members should be prepared to record videos.
