2. Comments from the Public-

2.1. Comment from Monique Jones- all persons who apply for positions have the right to be interviewed by the entire board before the president recommends a person for that position, I thought that the board follows the shared governance policy, just as the Delta College leadership. At this time I ask that you take my comments into consideration, in regard to the appointment of the ICC Chairperson. President Gormly clarification due to the phrasing of discussion items it is not actually appointment of the ICC at this point, it is the recommendation of the various applicants and it is in following with ASBG Constitution, and that has actually been the practice in years past. #### 4. Discussion Items

4.1. ID Card printer- Senator Borba- upgrade the printer that magnetic stripes. \$5-6000 for new one. Requesting a budget of \$6000.00  
Vice President Novak- paperwork to back up the pricing would appreciate.  
Senator Burr- how will the magnetic stripe be tied into the campus?  
Looking putting locks for lounges, discount programs, food card. This is more of a long term project looking to the future. The proceeds of the \$8 ID is split as such: \$7- to the ASBG, \$1- in administrative fees to the Bookstore.  
Motion to pass the budget of no more \$6000 Brandie- Motioned no second does not carry to the floor.

4.2 Summer Team Building- no rafting trip but we can incorporate a one half day event with the planning retreat mid to late august- looking at the Duke hotel in SF Ca because of their business friendly accommodations. Challenges indoor or out, this would be a three day weekend retreat. What is the goal? Information on the possible event- 1/2 day course, recommendation of the team performances challenge- President Gormly Planning the retreat and reservations for this trip- President Gormly will take charge. 22-24<sup>th</sup> with the assistance of Secretary Ratto.

4.3 SJRTD Rider-ship campaign- We have less parking and as we know parking is not easy to begin with here, We can rent parking at Circuit City SJRTD is willing to provide a free shuttle from the rented parking to campus, via shuttle Yokuts- Clairmont- march- pacific- burke Bradley, provided that we sell 600 passes per month at the discounted rate- \$25 the regular rate for a student is \$35. The challenge is 600 per month, 3 times more than we currently sell. ASBG  
Will be advertising the passes any ideas?  
Senator Burr recommends advertising via the clubs, banners and the radio.  
Treasurer Orona recommends advertising on the benches at the bus stop.  
Member of the Public- \$Stephanie Haskin- would the public be able to buy it or is this intended for the student. Community publications- use the marquee  
The passes would be a discounted pass not a student pass. Treasurer Orona- student id can be asked for at anytime, so make sure users have it on them.

What would you to liven up the ICC Meetings? Active participation- making it fun! Games more stimulation.

How would you deal with club tension and how would you improve club relations? Taking the clubs aside, after the meetings and resolving the problem.

Are you currently involved in clubs? Currently involved in AGS, student in the past year. Not that familiar to the clubs on campus.

President Gormly- hard look at the ICC, are you experienced with changing the constitution? She is more than willing to learn.
