### **Mentor Training for all campuses**

### **Database Update**

Another idea stemmed from the database discussion. The use of CSU Stanislaus mentors having access to student files at the community colleges is questionable: concerned about confidentiality.

### **STAMP**

Is STAMP approved as a name for the Title V program (Marcella was going to check with Activity I members)? Also, at a previous meeting, members were excited about the possibility of having STAMP on the CSU Stanislaus web site. Members are waiting for the approval on STAMP, and would like to see Title V on CSU Stanislaus' web page as soon as possible. Additionally, Jacquelyn Forté shared some ideas on a STAMP logo, and will continue to present prospective logos at future meetings.

### **Workshops**

A combination of several training topics will be used for mentor training. Dates for the workshops are TBA.

### **The 1-Credit Guidance Requirement**

Michelle Stanford has a concern because her guidance courses are 3 units, and the grant stipulates that it will cover funds for 1 unit. Is it possible for the grant to pay for 3 units? Members also want to ask Martha for her professional advice.

### **Special Cases**

Questions have developed regarding Title V participants: (a) Will there be any leniency on the grade point average requirement for participants? (b) Will students be able to participate if they do not meet all of the requirements (i.e. student is not 1<sup>st</sup> generation)? Members would like to further discuss the matter at the next meeting.
