Approval of Minutes

The May 20, 2004 minutes were approved as read.

International SI Conference Presentations

Kelvin Jasek-Rysdahl and Pat Wall presented information that they obtained from attending the three-day International SI Conference in Boston. Thirty-five states and nine countries were represented with approximately 200 conference participants. Jasek-Rysdahl stated one of the key factors he learned was that we should not feel we must be strictly tied to the guidelines we received during our SI training. He also felt the training we give to our SI Leaders needs to be more focused on theory.

Rodgers will make copies of the workshop handouts for the Activity Two Coordinators and send to them through the US mail.

After some discussion the group decided they would regionally develop a faculty satisfaction survey to be used by all campuses beginning fall 2004. The Regional Office staff will generate the first draft.

Re-Cap of Title V Council Presentation

Rodgers thanked the coordinators for their contributions to the presentation that was made to the Presidents, Chancellors, Vice Presidents and Provosts. The Council expressed their strong support of the grant activity and the dedicated work of the coordinators. The videotaping has been completed of the two students who gave testimonials. Rodgers thanked Marguerite Smith, Pam Upton, and Pat Wall for assisting to coordinate the presentation and taping.

Review and finalize SI Survey Format for Fall 2004

The coordinators approved the final three SI survey formats to be used for 2004-05: Beginning, Mid-Semester, and End-of-Term survey formats. The regional

research format will mirror the national SI format utilized by the University of Kansas.

Regional Research

Rodgers reminded the coordinators that they must submit all SI course information for spring 2004 to the Regional Title V office. A summary of data received and entered by the Regional Office was distributed to the coordinators indicating what specific information has not been submitted. Regional stats cannot be generated until all the information is obtained.

Scoring Rubric for Learning Aids

Pat Wall and Caroline Dawson are working on this task and plan to have a package of information available to SI Leaders for fall 2004. The learning aids will be organized utilizing the most difficult algebraic conceptions as identified through the HECCC ABASE Grant.
