



COVID COMPLIANCE Q & A #2

Rapid Antigen or PCR Testing Accommodation

An alternate method to a nasal swab test is available with medical accommodations. If you are unable to have a nasal swab test:

- 1) Please have your doctor fill out a medical note to explain the type of testing that you need as a medical accommodation.
- 2) Submit this documentation to Gabby Medrano in Human Resources (Gabby.Medrano@deltacollege.edu). You will have until November 30, 2021 to submit this documentation. Failure to submit documentation from your doctor regarding your medical accommodation by November 30, 2021 will result in you having to take the nasal swab test.

In the interim, you will be granted a temporary accommodation to receive alternate to the nasal swab test during this time provided you check the medical accommodation box on the [Test Information Kit Form](#). This form needs to be completed no later than October 23, 2021 by 11:59 PM.

At Home COVID-19 Testing Kits

You will be receiving an email by October 21, 2021 requesting information and asking for your COVID-19 testing preferences. Then the District will send you the COVID-19 testing kits, which will include instructions on how to complete the COVID-19 testing. COVID-19 testing should begin no later than November 1, 2021. Upon receipt of your COVID-19 testing kit, you should begin testing immediately per your COVID-19 testing pattern preference.

On Campus COVID-19 Testing

Starting October 25, 2021, individuals who are taking COVID-19 tests on campus should start COVID-19 testing based on their testing preference that they indicated on the Test Kit Information Form.

Any employee who has concern about possible exposure to COVID-19 has access to use the campus on-site COVID-19 testing center.

Non-Compliance with Vaccination Mandate Warning Letter Received in Error

If you believed you received a warning letter in error because you already submitted your proof of vaccination or applied for a medical or religious exemption or received an approval for a requested medical or religious exemption, please email COVID@deltacollege.edu. In your email, explain why you believe you received this letter in error.

Contact Tracing Notification

Our new contact tracing system is automated, and response times will be generated more quickly than they were with the previous manual system.

Students Who Are Also Employees

Please ensure your proof of vaccination is uploaded in both the student and employee vaccination submission forms.

If you are requesting an exemption, you will also need to submit your request for exemption in both the student and employee exemption submission forms.
