



Topics

• Select hot topics on **social issues** from online databases such as *Opposing Viewpoints* and *PowerSearch*

Search Evaluate

- Conduct **Subject** or **Keyword** searches in **PowerSearch**
- Limit to **full-text** and **peer-reviewed** publications
- Select and evaluate retrieved journal articles

Save Cite

- Have the full-text article printed or e-mailed or read for you
- Use the Citation Tool to cite the sources and tweak the citations with MLA citation guide



While the corporal punishment of children is an important topic for investigation, Straus' model fails to demonstrate how the physical punishment of children results in the adult use of violence towards children, "spouse abuse," assault, and homicide. The model is not based on an adequate conception of human learning or development; nor does it provide a suitable theoretical basis for privileging corporal punishment as a major cause of adult violence. Finally, the model fails to provide a context of gender, class, and race for interpreting an individual's experience and use of violent acts.

Murray Straus has once again drawn attention to an important issue concerning violence in the family—the physical punishment of children. His proposed research project is in the
