- ✓ African American, American Indian-Alaska Native, Asian & Pacific Islander American, or Hispanic American
- ✓ U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Foreign National
- ✓ High school senior, GED recipient, or high school graduate entering an
  accredited college for the first time, as a full-time, degree-seeking, firstyear student
- ✓ Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3
- Must apply for federal financial aid using the <u>Free Application for</u>
   <u>Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u>

# ¡ADELANTE! FUND MILLERCOORS ENGINEERING AND SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP

- -College junior or senior by the fall semester
- -Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- -Must be of Hispanic descent
- -Must have a 3.0 GPA or above
- -Maintain full-time enrollment status (12 hours) for the duration of the scholarship period
- -Provide two letters of recommendation highlighting leadership potential
- -Scholar must attend ¡Adelante!'s Annual Leadership Institute in San Antonio,
- TX (Scholarship includes airfare, hotel accommodations, and conference registration)
- -Must attend a partnering university

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

- -Each applicant must fulfill all the requirements listed below:
- -Intent on pursuing a career in the actuarial profession
- -Must have at least one birth parent who is a member of one of the following minority groups: Black/African American, Hispanic, Native North American, Pacific Islander
- -Will be a full-time undergraduate student at a U.S. accredited educational institution
- -Minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), emphasis on math or actuarial courses
- -Entering college freshmen must have a minimum ACT math score of 28 or SAT math score of 600

- -50 semester units (or equivalent) of college credits completed with an official copy of college transcript and a 2.5 or better GPA (cumulative)
- -Enrollment in a culinary arts college in California
- -Prior completed units (or equivalent) of college credits not necessary to apply
