French AA-T (Associate in Arts for Transfer)
Students may prepare for an Associate of Arts Degree in French through a sequential course of studies (1 1/2 to 2 years) leading to transfer to a four-year institution.

- FREN 50H Special Studies: French (Units: 1-2)
- HUM 4 Introduction to Linguistics (Units: 3)

or

- ANTHR 4 Introduction to Linguistics (Units: 3)
- HUM 19 Selected Topics: Study and Travel (Units: 0.5-4)

CSU General Education, CSU IGETC and UC IGETC, you need a 2nd semester (level 2) course in the language.
