Longevity increases of 2.5% of the base salary will be applied as follows:
Effective July 1 of the ninth (9th), thirteenth (13th), seventeenth (17th), twenty-first (21st), and twenty-fifth (25th) years of consecutive, continuous employment.

Managers possessing an earned doctorate receive an additional salary; the difference between columns VI and VII of the Contract and Regular Faculty Salary Schedule for 2016-17 through 2018-19, which is \$2,311 annually.
