STATEMENT OF COMMITMENT AND SPECIAL PARTNERSHIP- PATHWAY TO LAW PROGRAM

In addition to the benefits of participation in the statewide Pathway to Law program, the regional agreement with Humphreys provides the following additional benefits for Pathway to Law Students:

1. **Visiting with Humphreys and Law School Classes:** Drivon School of Law will be available to visit classes and make presentations at Delta College, as well as to meet with Pathway students and offer said students to sit in on law classes at the law school.
2. **Eligibility for Admission to Law School:** Pathway students with 60 semester units qualifying for transfer toward a BA degree are admissible to the law school if the Pathway student is otherwise qualified (e.g., Pathway applicants to the law school must have completed an LSAT examination on application or will be required to take the examination during their first quarter).
3. **Accelerated BA/BS and JD Degree Option:** For Pathway students wishing to first obtain a BA or BS degree, they will be eligible to first attend one year in the Criminal Justice or Legal Studies program at Humphreys University and then transfer into the law school with the first year of law school also being the final year of study for the BA or BS degree in the Criminal Justice or Legal Studies program.
4. **More Holistic Application Review:** The applications of Pathway students will be viewed with the goal of inclusion of underrepresented communities in our legal system and with the goal of providing the opportunity to those who seek legal education in a less expensive and more inclusive night program.
5. **\$2,500 First Year of Law School Tuition Reduction:** Because the federal loan program will not offer full graduate degree support until the law student has 90 semester units, Drivon School of Law will offer a \$2,500.00 reduction in tuition for an admitted law student's first year.
6. **Application Fee Waiver:** Pathway students identifying themselves as Pathway students on the application will have no application fee.
7. **Data Policy:** Drivon School of Law will maintain statistical data for all admitted Pathway students and communicate that data to the Pathways officials as much as is allowed by state and federal laws and the Committee of Bar Examiners for California.
8. **Regional Collaboration:** Representatives from Drivon School of Law will attend annual summit conferences to meet regional partners to establish a working relationship with shared insights on the program.
